Application for Capacity – Indonesia route

Effective from 14 December 2019, Qantas Airways Limited's (Qantas) wholly-owned subsidiary, Jetstar Airways Pty Limited (Jetstar), plans to operate four additional weekly services between Australia and Indonesia.

It is planned that the service will be operated using A320-200 aircraft configured with 186 seats.

Allocation Sought

Qantas requests an allocation of 744 seats per week on the Indonesia route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 31 December 2019;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in support of this application.
