Renewal of Commission Determination – South Africa

Thank you for your recent letter which invited Qantas to express its interest in the renewal of determinations allocating capacity which will expire in the next 12 months.

Qantas requests renewal of Determination [2012] IASC 106, as varied by [2012] IASC 223, which allocates seven frequencies per week in each direction on the South Africa route. For flexibility, the capacity is also sought for use by another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas, such as Jetstar.

We therefore seek to renew the Determination subject to the following conditions:

- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require in considering our renewal request.
