## DECISION

### 1 The application

1.1 On 10 June 2026, Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Limited (Virgin Australia) applied to the International Air Services Commission (the Commission) to revoke, pursuant to section 27AA of the *International Air Services Commission Act 1992* (the Act):

- Determination [2021] IASC 117 (varied by Decision [2024] IASC 207), which allocates to Virgin Australia 910 seats of passenger capacity on the Samoa route.

1.2 In its application, Virgin Australia requested the revocation decision to take effect from 1 September 2026.

### 2 Commission's consideration

2.1 Under subsection 27AA(1) of the Act, an Australian carrier to whom a determination allocating capacity is issued, may at any time request the Commission to revoke the determination.

2.2 Upon receipt of an application to revoke a determination, the Commission must make a decision revoking the determination pursuant to subsection 27AA(3).

### 3 Decision [2026] IASC 207

3.1 In accordance with section 27AA of the Act, the Commission revokes Determination [2021] IASC 117 with effect from 1 September 2026.
