RE: APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY – INDONESIA ROUTE

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) wishes to apply for an allocation of capacity on the Indonesia route.

The additional capacity would enable Qantas to upgauge selected Sydney-Denpasar services from B737 to A330 aircraft configured with 271 seats during periods of high demand.

Allocation Sought

Qantas seeks an allocation of 162 seats per week on the Indonesia route on the following basis:

- The allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the Determination;
- The capacity will be fully utilised by 5 December 2022;
- The capacity may be utilised by Qantas, Jetstar or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- The capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.
