**RE: APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY – FIJI ROUTE**

Qantas Airways Limited's (Qantas) wholly-owned subsidiary, Jetstar Airways Pty Limited (Jetstar), plans to add one additional service between Sydney and Nadi in periods of peak demand throughout the year.

The capacity will be utilised to increase Jetstar's JQ 119/120 Sydney-Nadi-Sydney service to a daily operation during peak periods. Services will be operated using A320 aircraft configured with 186 seats.

Allocation sought:

Qantas seeks an allocation of 165 seats per week on the Fiji route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the determination;
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 15 December 2022;
- the capacity may be utilised by Qantas, Jetstar or another Australian carrier which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Qantas; and
- the capacity may be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission may require.
