RE RENEWAL OF DETERMINATIONS – SOUTH AFRICA, SINGAPORE, ITALY, INDONESIA AND FIJI

Thank you for your letter dated 9 December 2021 regarding the renewal of determinations allocating capacity to Qantas Airways Limited and its wholly owned subsidiary Jetstar Airways Pty Limited that expire between December 2022 and June 2023.

SOUTH AFRICA ROUTE – Determination [2017] IASC 102

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2017] IASC 102 which allocates seven frequencies of capacity
per week on the South Africa route for a period of five years, expiring on 16 December 2022. Qantas
requests all existing conditions be retained.

SINGAPORE ROUTE - Determination [2017] IASC 106

 Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2017] IASC 106 which allocates 300 seats per week on the Singapore route to be used to exercise own stop-over rights between Singapore and Colombo for a period of five years, expiring on 20 March 2022. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

ITALY ROUTE – Determination [2018] IASC 101

 Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 101 which allocates 300 third-country code share seats per week, averaged over 12-months for a period of five years, expiring on 1 March 2023. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

INDONESIA ROUTE - Determination [2018] IASC 104

 Qantas seeks renewal of the Determination [2018] IASC 104 which allocates 1,260 seats per week on the Indonesia route for a period of five years, expiring on 21 February 2023. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.



FIJI ROUTE – Determination [2018] IASC 111

• Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 111 which allocates 258 seats per week in each direction of passenger capacity on the Fiji route for a period of five years, expiring on 14 June 2023. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.
