**RE APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY – KOREA ROUTE**

From 1 December 2020, or as soon as all necessary approvals have been received, Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) plans to serve Korea on a scheduled basis using various routings, which includes China and the United States.

The services will be operated using B747-400F and Boeing 747-8F aircraft wet leased from Atlas Air.

Allocation Sought

Qantas requests an allocation of unlimited capacity for all-cargo services on the Korea route on the following basis:

- the allocation is requested for a period of 99 years from the date of the determination; and
- the capacity will be fully utilised by 30 January 2021.
