RE: RENEWAL DETERMINATION

Qantas Airways Limited (**Qantas**) wishes to renew Determination [2015] IASC 108 allocating unlimited capacity and frequency per week to Qantas on the United Kingdom route, expiring 30 August 2026.

Until travel restrictions linked to the COVID-19 pandemic were imposed by the Australian Government in March 2020, Qantas operated regular passenger services between points in Australia and the United Kingdom. In November 2021, Qantas resumed scheduled services between the two countries and continues to operate on the route today, with double daily services from Australia to London Heathrow.

Qantas requests renewal of Determination [2015] IASC 108 for a period of 99 years, including the ability for the capacity to be used by Qantas to provide joint services with any wholly-owned subsidiary and by any wholly-owned subsidiary of the Qantas Group to provide joint services with Qantas.

IASC Act and Policy Statement Considerations

We request that this application be considered against the 'reasonable capability criterion' as defined in section 8 of the Minister's Policy Statement. Qantas continues to hold the licences, permits and relevant approvals required to operate on and service the route.

We would be pleased to provide any further information the Commission requires.
