APPLICATION FOR VARIATION – SINGAPORE

Qantas' wholly-owned subsidiary, Jetstar Airways Pty Limited (Jetstar), and Air Pacific Limited (trading as Fiji Airways) plan to code share on flights operated by Jetstar on the Singapore route from 26 March 2023.

A copy of the confidential code share agreement between Jetstar and Fiji Airways will be provided separately to the Commission.

Variation sought

Qantas seeks a variation to Determination [2017] IASC 131, which allocates unlimited capacity on the Singapore route, to permit Fiji Airways to code share on Jetstar operated services. The variation is requested for the duration of the Determination.

We request that this application be considered against the 'reasonable capability criterion' as defined in section 8 of the Minister's Policy Statement.
