Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) appreciates the opportunity to express its interest in the renewal of various determinations allocating capacity to Qantas, which will expire between July and December 2023.

Cook Islands route – Determination [2018] IASC 115

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 115, which allocates 204 seats per week on the Cook Islands route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Fiji route – Determination [2018] IASC 122

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 122, which allocates 696 seats per week on the Fiji route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Indonesia route – Determinations [2018] IASC 120 and [2017] IASC 130

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 120 and [2017] 130, which allocates 1,250 seats per week and 14,468 seats per week and 2,148 seats per week for beyond with 12 frequencies per week respectively on the Indonesia route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

New Caledonia route – Determination [2018] IASC 113

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 113, which allocates 100 seats per week on the New Caledonia route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Philippines route – Determination [2018] IASC 112

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2018] IASC 112, which allocates 152 seats per week on the Philippines route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.
