RE: RENEWAL DETERMINATIONS

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) appreciates the opportunity to express its interest in the renewal of various determinations allocating capacity to Qantas which will expire between March and April 2024.

New Zealand route – Determination [2014] IASC 102

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2014] IASC 102, which allocates unlimited freight and passenger capacity on the New Zealand route for a period of 99 years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Indonesia – Determination [2019] IASC 106

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2019] IASC 106, which allocates 284 seats per week on the Indonesia route for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Cook Islands – Determination [2019] IASC 107

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2019] IASC 107, which allocates 372 seats per week on the Cook Islands route for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

Qantas has provided the Commission with a copy of the confidential code share agreements relevant to the above renewal requests.
