## **APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY – SOLOMON ISLANDS ROUTE**

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) is currently operating passenger services on the Solomon Islands route in accordance with Determination [2023] IASC 121 which allocates Qantas 291 seats of capacity per week.

From 5 June 2024, Qantas plans to increase scheduled services to operate an additional weekly service between Brisbane and Honiara. The service will be operated by Embraer E190 aircraft configured with 97 seats under a wet lease agreement with Alliance Airlines. The proposed schedule is provided below.

## **Allocation Sought**

Qantas seeks an allocation of 97 seats per week in each direction on the Solomon Islands route with capacity to be fully utilised by 12 June 2024. The allocation is requested for a period of five years from the date of the Determination.
