**RE: RENEWAL DETERMINATIONS**

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) appreciates the opportunity to express its interest in the renewal of various determinations allocating capacity to Qantas, which will expire between January and February 2024.

**New Caledonia route – Determination [2019] IASC 101**

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2019] IASC 101, which allocates 156 seats per week on the New Caledonia route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained.

**Korea route – Determination [2019] IASC 103**

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2019] IASC 103, which allocates 400 seats per week on the Korea route, for a period of five years. Qantas requests all existing conditions be retained, except for the condition permitting the use of code share capacity with Hong Kong Dragon Airlines Limited (Cathay Dragon).

Qantas has provided the Commission with a copy of the confidential code share agreements relevant to the above renewal requests.
