Indonesia competing applications for capacity

Perth Airport supports a substantial increase in the available bilateral capacity to enable Australian airlines to operate more services to Indonesia.

Under the current arrangement, there is no available capacity for an Australian airline to operate any new services between Indonesia and Australia's major capital city airports.

Denpasar is the number one route from Perth with 64 weekly services based on the current schedule. Of these, only 21 weekly services are operated by an Australian airline (Jetstar). In addition, 53 of these weekly services are operated by a low-cost carrier.

Perth Airport also recognises that Virgin Australia is proposing additional domestic routes to Perth in conjunction with new Perth-Denpasar services that would also be beneficial for increasing capacity and consumer choice.
