Renewal Determinations

Thank you for your letter of 10 August 2021 in relation to renewal determinations for the Italy (IASC 119) and Samoa (IASC 120) routes.

Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd (Virgin Australia) wishes to advise that it is seeking to renew both determinations made on 10 August 2017 for a period of five years in anticipation of the re-opening of international borders in late-2021 and early-2022.

Subject to the revision of dates in the current determination, Virgin Australia does not propose any other changes to the conditions which were set out by the Commission.

Virgin Australia also asks the Commission to note our consistent position on resuming international operations which have been suspended since March 2020.

We continue to regularly review the opportunity to re-commence short and long-haul international services and respond to the latest advice. Our services to Queenstown (New Zealand) and Nadi (Fiji) are due to re-commence in December 2021 and we expect other services including Denpasar (Indonesia) to re-commence from March 2022.
