Dear Ms. Jasmina,

Virgin Australia International Airlines Pty Ltd respectfully submits this application to renew Determination [2020] IASC 105, covering the Australia–Indonesia route. This determination, which allocates 120 seats per week in each direction to Virgin Australia, is currently valid from 30 August 2021 until 29 August 2026.

This application seeks renewal of the existing allocation of 120 seats per week, each direction, for a further five-year with retention of all existing conditions.

Virgin Australia confirms that the allocated capacity has been effectively utilised, except during the COVID-19 pandemic period when operations were unavoidably impacted. For Northern Summer 2025, bilateral entitlements have been fully utilised across key routes: Brisbane–Denpasar, Sydney–Denpasar, Melbourne–Denpasar, and Perth–Denpasar.

Virgin Australia has consistently demonstrated its ability to operate services under this determination, supported by utilisation of bilateral entitlements. Renewal of this allocation will preserve and enhance competition, ensure consumer choice, and maintain reliable connectivity between Australia and Indonesia.
