## Vietnam Route - Determination [2017] IASC 103

Qantas seeks renewal of Determination [2017] IASC 103 which allocates seven frequencies of capacity
per week on the Vietnam route for a period of five years, expiring on 20 March 2022. Qantas requests
all existing conditions be retained.

## France Route #1 – Determination [2016] IASC 108

Qanats seeks renewal of Determination [2016] IASC 108, which allocates 250 one-way seats per day
of capacity on the France Route #1 for a period of five years, expiring on 21 May 2022. Qantas
requests all existing conditions be retained.
